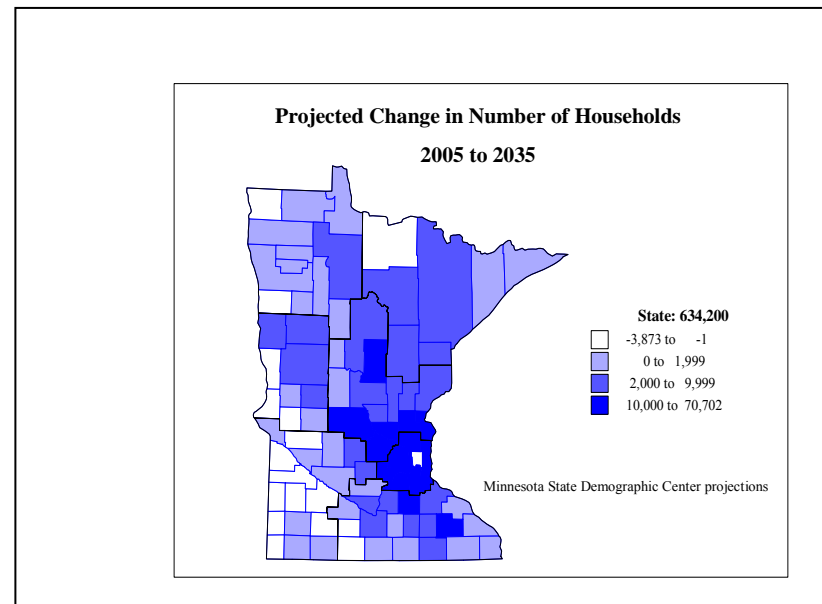
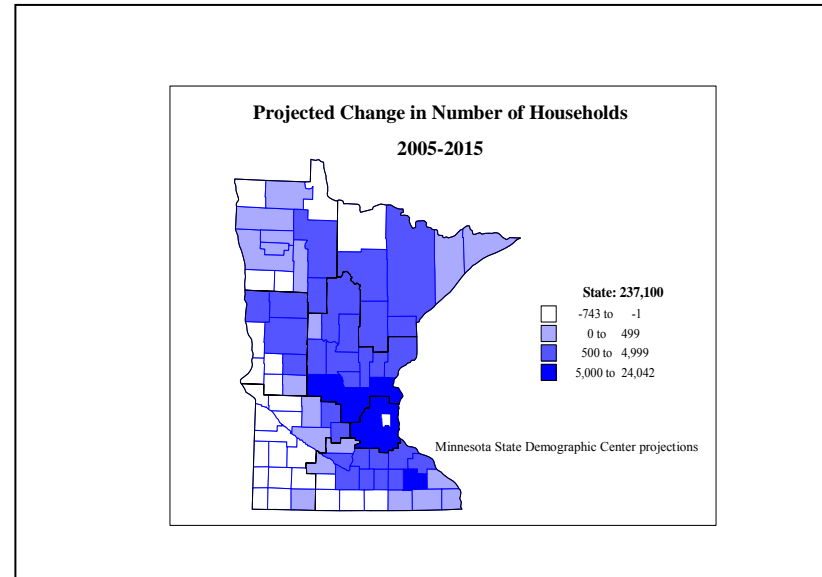

- The number of Minnesota households is projected to reach 2,257,210 by 2015 and 2,654,380 by 2035, up from 2,020,144 in 2005.
- As the baby boom generation continues to age, the number of married couples without children living at home will grow by 120,700 between 2005 and 2015.
- Between 2010 and 2030 the number of one-person households headed by a person 65 and older will grow by 156,000, another trend related to baby boom aging.
- The number of married couples with children will fall by 24,500 between 2005 and 2015.
- Household gains will be greatest in the suburban ring around the Twin Cities.

The number of households in Minnesota is projected to grow 12

percent between 2005 and 2015 and 31 percent between 2005 and 2035. This overall gain is the product of a growing, aging population. The state's population is projected to grow 10 percent in the first decade and 24 percent over the 30-year period, and population growth will fuel much of the increase in households. Households will grow a bit faster than population because the average household size will shrink slightly. The smaller household size results from an aging population. As the baby boomers grow older, more people will be living in small one-person or two-person households instead of in larger families.

The rate of household growth will be slightly lower than in the past. Between 1970 and 1980 the number of households grew 25 percent. The level of increase then tapered off to 14 percent between 1980 and 1990 and 15 percent between 1990 and 2005.



Twin Cities area will add the most households

More than two-thirds of the state’s new households added between 2005 and 2015 will live in the 11 Minnesota counties of the Minneapolis-St. Paul Metropolitan area. About 161,700 additional households are projected for this region during the decade, a gain of 14 percent. The highest growth rates are projected for Scott (58 percent) and Sherburne (48 percent), and Wright and Chisago counties. Dakota, Scott and Anoka counties will each add about 24,000 new households.

Outside the Twin Cities area, the number of households is projected to show strong growth in the Rochester area and in a band of counties north of the Twin Cities. Carlton County (24 percent), Pine County (21 percent) and Kanabec County (20 percent) are among the counties projected to have the highest rates of household growth between 2005 and 2015.

Scott County is projected to add 70,000 households between 2005 and 2035, the most of any county. Dakota, Anoka and Wright counties are all expected to add more than 50,000 households during the same time period.

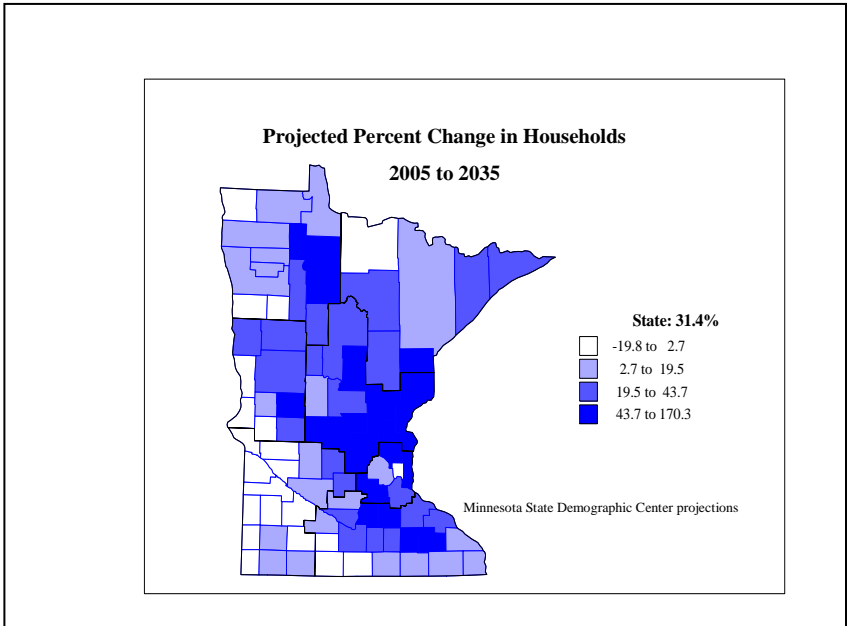
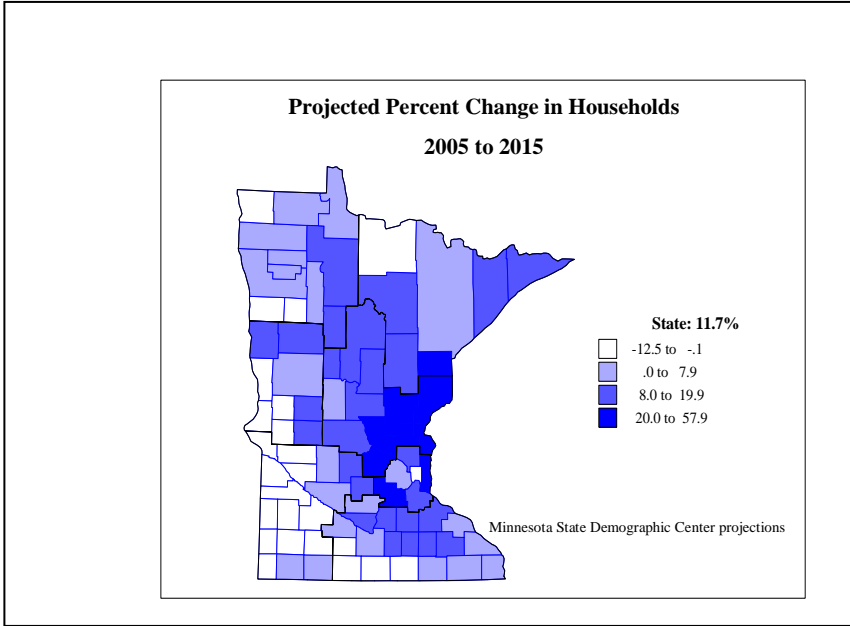
Household types will change

The increasing number of households will be accompanied by a shift in household type. The number of married couples with children will not change much, while the number of non-family households and married couples without children will increase rapidly. These changes reflect both the aging of the population and changes in social customs and lifestyles, and they will affect all areas of the state.

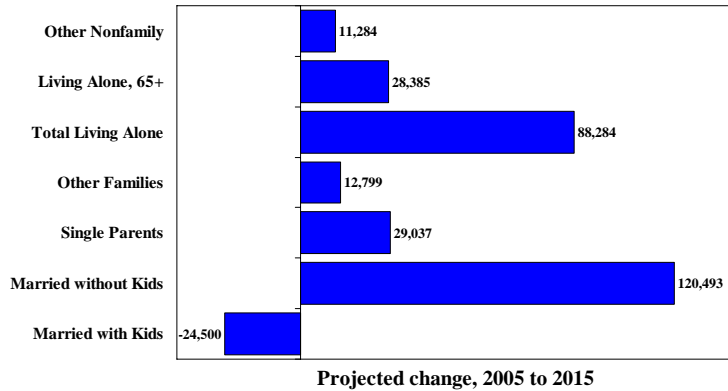
Number of married couples with children projected to fall slightly

In 2005, 24 percent of Minnesota’s households were married couple families with related children. By 2035, only 18 percent of households will be of this type. The number of couples with children is projected to decline slightly over the next three decades, from an estimated 486,132 in 2005 to 478,140 by 2035, with some minor ups and downs in intervening years.

As the population ages, the proportion of people in their child-bearing and child-rearing years will decline. This is the major reason for the stagnant number of married couples with children. In addition, the projections assume that more of the people who have young children will be single

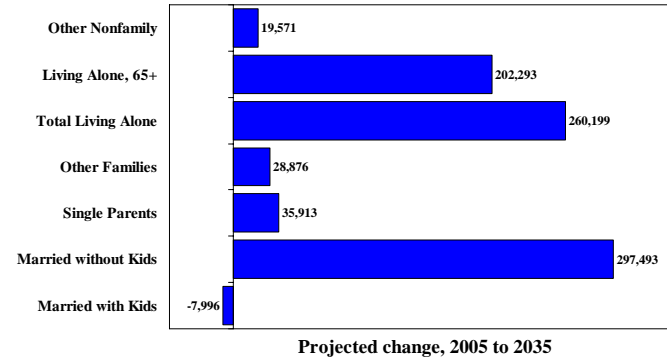


Childless couples and 1-person households projected to grow



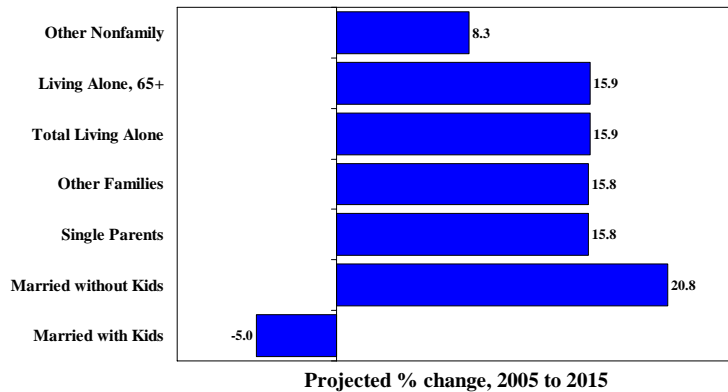

parents or will be in a cohabitating relationship rather than a marriage.

Number of married couples without children will increase

The aging of the baby boom will produce a large increase in the number of married couples without children living at home. The married couple without children category includes young couples who may have children later and couples who will never have children, as well as those whose children have grown up and left home. The latter group, the empty nesters, will be responsible for most of the growth in this type of

household. Using this definition, couples who have children 18 or older still living at home are also counted as married couples without children.

By 2005, there were already substantially more married couples without children, 578,437, than couples with children, 486,132. The number of childless couples is projected to grow by 120,700 between 2005 and 2015, an increase of 21 percent. Further growth of 177,800 is anticipated between 2015 and 2035.

Number of other families without children will increase

The number of families who are not married couples and do not have young children in the home is projected to grow 16 percent, or 12,800 households, between 2005 and 2015. This category includes unmarried people living with their adult children or grandchildren as well as people living with brothers, sisters or any other relatives. In 2005, about 4 percent of all households fit this definition. Overall, the number of unmarried families with children is expected to grow at about the same rate as the total number of households.

One-person households will grow in number and proportion

In 2005, 28 percent of Minnesota households contained only one person. By 2035, 31 percent of all households will be one-person households. The number of one-person households is projected to increase from 555,613 in 2005 to 817,080 in 2035.

The number of living-alone households with a householder ages 65 or older will grow from 179,297 in 2005 to 383,460 in 2035. A big surge in elderly one-person households will occur after 2010, when the effect of the baby boom will become very evident.

Other non-family households will grow slowly

The number of non-family households is projected to grow 8 percent between 2005 and 2015 and 15 percent between 2005 and 2035. This category includes households with unmarried partners, people living with roommates and other settings where people live with non-relatives. In 2005 about 7 percent of all Minnesota households fit into this category.

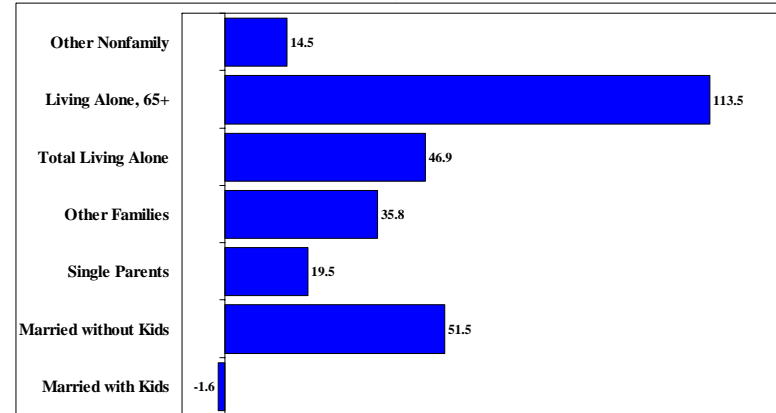
Average household size will fall slightly.

Assuming that the proportion of the population living in households remains the same, average household size in Minnesota will fall from 2.50 in 2005 to 2.46 in 2015 and 2.36 in 2035. Household size will decline because the number of households is projected to grow faster than the number of people. This reflects the aging of the population and the growing prevalence of smaller types of households, such as empty nesters and one-person households.

Methodology

The projected number of households is the product of the projected population by age and

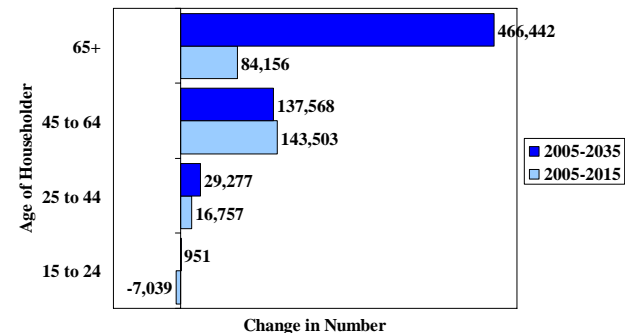
Number of elderly living alone will more than double over the next 30 years

sex and projected householder rates by age and sex. The householder rate equals the number of householders in each age/gender group divided by the total population in that age/gender group.

Population projections by age and gender come from *Minnesota Population Projections 2005-2035*, published by the State Demographic Center in June, 2007.

For the state, the baseline householder rates were computed using the 2005 American Community Survey Public Use Microdata Sample and the Census 2000 Public Use Microdata Sample. For 2000, the number of householders and the population by age both came from the 2000 Census Microdata. For 2005, information on household types by age came from the 2005 ACS Microdata and the population base came from 2005 Census Bureau estimates.

The household types are: married couples with related children under age 18, married couples without related children, male householder families with related children under 18, male householder families without related children, female householder families with related children under 18, female householder families without

related children, males living alone, other male non-family households, females living alone, and other female non-family households.

The statewide rate of change in each householder rate by age and sex between 2005 and 2015 was assumed to be the same as the rate of change between 2000 and 2005. The resulting values were then controlled to the 2005 total householder rate in that age/gender group. Rates for 2010 were halfway between the estimated 2005 and projected 2015 rates. After 2015, householder rates were held constant.

At the county level, no detailed data on householder type by age was available for 2005, so rates based on 2000 Census data were used. The baseline rates were the same as those used in *Minnesota Household Projections 2000-2030*, published by the Minnesota State Demographic Center in December, 2003. These baseline rates were applied to the projected county population by age and sex from *Minnesota Population Projections 2005-2035*. The total number of households in each age, gender and household type category was controlled to the projected state number.

The 2000 census baseline numbers for counties were estimated using a combination of published census tables and regional data from the 2000 Public Use Microdata Sample. The census tabulates the number of total family and non-family householders for the following age groups: 15 to 24, 25 to 34, 35 to 44, 45 to 54, 55 to 64, 65 to 74, 75 to 84, and 85 and over. The census also contains data on more detailed household types, including married couples with and without children, single parents, other family households, one-person households and other non-family households. This detailed household type information is not available by age and sex, however.

The breakdown into detailed household type by age and gender was estimated using the 2000 census 5-Percent Public Use Microdata Sample. In the PUMS data, the state is divided into geographic areas containing a minimum of 100,000 people. Counties with small populations are grouped to form Public Use Microdata Areas. For example, Clay, Kittson, Marshall, Norman, Pennington, Polk, Red Lake and Roseau counties are all included in a single Public Use Microdata Area.

The initial assumption was that the distribution of family and non-family types by age and sex was the same in each county as in the Public Use Microdata Area where that county was located. For example, if 25 percent of all 15- to 24-year-old family householders in a Microdata Area were married couple householders with children, it was assumed the same was true for 15- to 24-year-old family householders in each county within the PUMA.

Larger counties such as Hennepin, Ramsey and Dakota contain multiple Public Use Microdata Areas. In these counties, the householder proportions were calculated for the combined PUMAs making up the county and then applied to the age/gender county householder data.

The numbers resulting from this initial distribution were raked several times so they would match more closely both the county census number of family and non-family households by age and also the county number of households of the following detailed household types: married couple households with a male householder with own children under 18, married couple households with a male householder without own children under 18, other families with a male householder with own

children under 18, other families with a male householder without own children under 18, married couple households with a female householder with own children under 18, married couple households with a female householder without own children under 18, other families with a female householder with own children under 18, other families with a female householder without own children under 18, one-person households with a male householder, one-person households with a female householder, other non-family households with a male householder, and other non-family households with a female householder.

The final result of the raking process was a tally that exactly matched the county number of family and non-family householders by age and was extremely close to the county number of households by detailed type. The detailed household type numbers were then divided by the 2000 census population counts by age and gender to obtain householder rates by detailed household type.

The county total number of households in each age/gender/household type category was controlled to the state

total. County numbers are rounded to the nearest 10, and state numbers to the nearest 100.

Sources of error

There are many potential sources of error in household projections. The population projections could be too high or too low. Total householder rates by age and gender could go up or down, instead of remaining constant as is assumed here. Changes in householder types could occur faster or slower than projected, or could change in the opposite direction.

Census definitions sometimes scramble to keep up with changes in social behavior, and household types have become very complex. For example, take the case of a household that includes a man, a woman, and a small child who is the biological child of the woman but not the man. If this pair is married, they will be classified as a married couple with a child. If they are not married and the woman is listed as the householder, the household will be considered a female householder single parent family. If they are not married and the man is listed as the householder, it will be counted as an other non-family householder because the householder is not

related to the woman or the child. Future classifications of household type may change to reflect the rise in cohabitation and other shifts in living arrangements. This report uses current census classifications and does not attempt to anticipate future changes.
